



- Ostendo integrates with the following Accounting Software Products:
 - MYOB AccountRight (Desktop and Cloud)
 - MYOB Essentials (Q1 2020)
 - Reckon Accounts (Desktop and Hosted)
 - Xero
 - Sage Pastel Evolution
 - MoneyWorks
 - QuickBooks OnLine (QBO)
- As Ostendo stores all financial transactions, scripting can be used to export this data out to other Accounting Software if required
- Ostendo allows you to manage your Invoicing / Payments and Accounts Receivable from within its own framework and simply pass General Ledger Journals to the accounting software. In more later versions of Accounting Software, Ostendo can alternatively pass the sales invoices directly through to the Accounting Software Accounts Receivable Ledger. Payments can then be made either from within that software or alternatively within Ostendo.
- Purchase Invoices processed through Ostendo are passed directly to the Accounting Software Creditors Ledger ready for Payment. (No double handling)
- Ostendo can pass the Accounting Software "Tracking Code" (Xero) or "Job" (MYOB) along with the financial transaction.
- Optional full Multi Currency capability is offered within Ostendo, even if the accounting software is configured for local currency only.
- All data passed from Ostendo to the Accounting Software contains references back to the source transactions within Ostendo allowing for full traceability.
- Ability to control which Revenue and COS General Ledger accounts are posted to, based on the type of goods or order processed within Ostendo.
- Control Financial Cut Off dates in Ostendo to prevent users from posting back to a closed accounting period.
